KHO KHO

(BOYS" & GIRLS")

1. The rules as adopted by the Kho Kho Federation of India apply, with modifications wherever applicable.
2. All the matches at Cluster level will be played on Knockout basis. In case the numbers of teams reporting are 8 or less than 8, the tournament may be conducted on league cum knock out basis.
3. From each Cluster, only first position winning team will qualify to participate in the CBSE National Championship.
4. All the matches at National level shall be played on league cum knock out basis.
5. At National level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that bye and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.
6. In matches played on league basis, "points for minus the total points against" shall decide the tie. Should the tie still persist; it shall be decided by "spin of coin".
7. A team shall consist of a maximum number of twelve players.
8. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.

ELIGIBILITY

Age:

The athlete/player should be within the particular age group on 31 December of the year of competition.

- a. Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School tournaments/meets. Feeding any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- b. A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- c. Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- d. Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- e. The original eligibility Performa of the Athletes / Players / Teams qualifying to participate from Cluster / Zone level to National level will have to be certified by the Organizing school at the Cluster / Zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the 7 National Organizing School, immediately after their Cluster / Zone level competition is over.
- f. Medical check up may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion.
- g. A player shall be under 17 & 19 years of age as on 31 Dec of the year of event. Accordingly, for session 2018-19 sports events, the age criteria will be as follows:
 1. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2002
 2. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2000
- h. All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager / Coach while reporting for participation.
- i. The players right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.

Any team / athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament / meet shall not be permitted to participate.

ACCOMMODATION IN HOST SCHOOL

- ❖ Boys and Girls Lodging and Boarding in separate.
- ❖ Teams will be allotted separate rooms for girls and boys.
- ❖ The accompanying teacher/coach will be staying with their team only.
- ❖ Jamakkalam will be provided on the stipulated payment as per CBSE norms which will include breakfast, lunch, tea and dinner.

CODE OF CONDUCT / IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE

- ❖ Each school will send one staff member as Manager and one as coach of the team.
- ❖ Consumption of Liquor, Drugs, and Tobacco in any form is strictly prohibited during the conduct of the tournament and stay in the school. Anyone who violates this rule will be immediately removed from the school campus and the team will be disqualified.
- ❖ Participants are not allowed to wear any costly ornaments or bring any valuable items. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any articles during the stay.
- ❖ Each school must issue an Identity Card to every player of its school, separately for each category in which the student intends to participate as per the format of CBSE.
- ❖ No player shall be permitted to participate in the CBSE Cluster without their Original Identity Card having the counter signature of the Principal of the respective Cluster / Zone Level Competition organizing school.
- ❖ The norms of eligibility criteria Withdrawal of the teams, Disqualification and protest will be followed as per the guidelines and rules prescribed by the CBSE.
- ❖ All the schools have to deposit Rs.2000/- as caution deposit which is refundable. This money will not be refundable in case of any damage or loss to the property caused by a particular school team.
- ❖ All matches will be played in the school campus.
- ❖ The norms of eligibility criteria Withdrawal of the teams, Disqualification and protest will be followed as per the guidelines and rules prescribed by the CBSE.

Only vegetarian food will be provided.

PROTEST

- Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within 1 hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (One Thousand only).
- Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following:-
 1. Principal, Organizing School
 2. Organizing Secretary
 3. CBSE observer
 4. One or two technically qualified People present at the venue
- In case the protest is upheld, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.
- The decision taken by Jury of Appeal will be final.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PARTICIPATING TEAMS

- ❖ Participating teams staying on campus are requested to fill the attached Proforma and Email to alagujothiacademy@yahoo.com or before 31st August 2018.
- ❖ Participating teams staying outside the campus are requested to make their own arrangements for food and transportation.
- ❖ The teams returning shall be eligible for refund of payment deposited, but only for the post 24 hours balance meals.
- ❖ Class room accommodation with toilet and bathroom facilities will be provided to the team members on campus.

AIA RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ❖ The team member may please be instructed to observe discipline, code of conduct and use the school property with at most vigilance.
- ❖ School will not be responsible for any kind of loss of valuables including gold, ornaments, mobile phones or money.
- ❖ If school property damaged by the participating team members, the damage cost will be incurred by them only.
